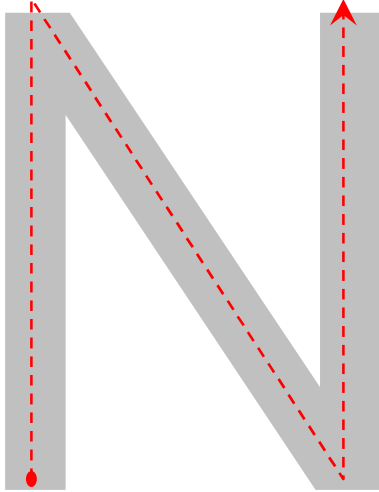

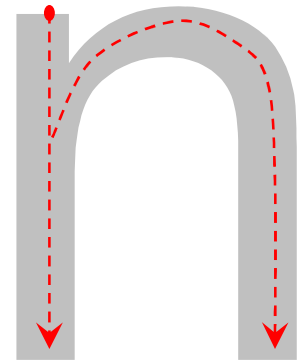
# The Letter L

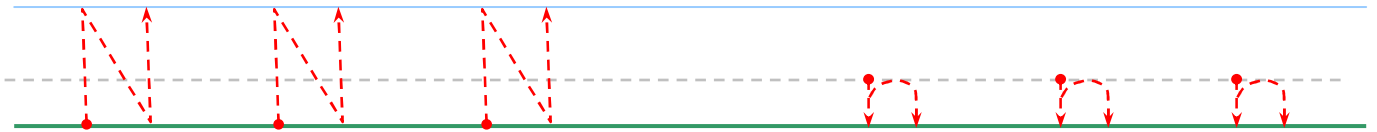

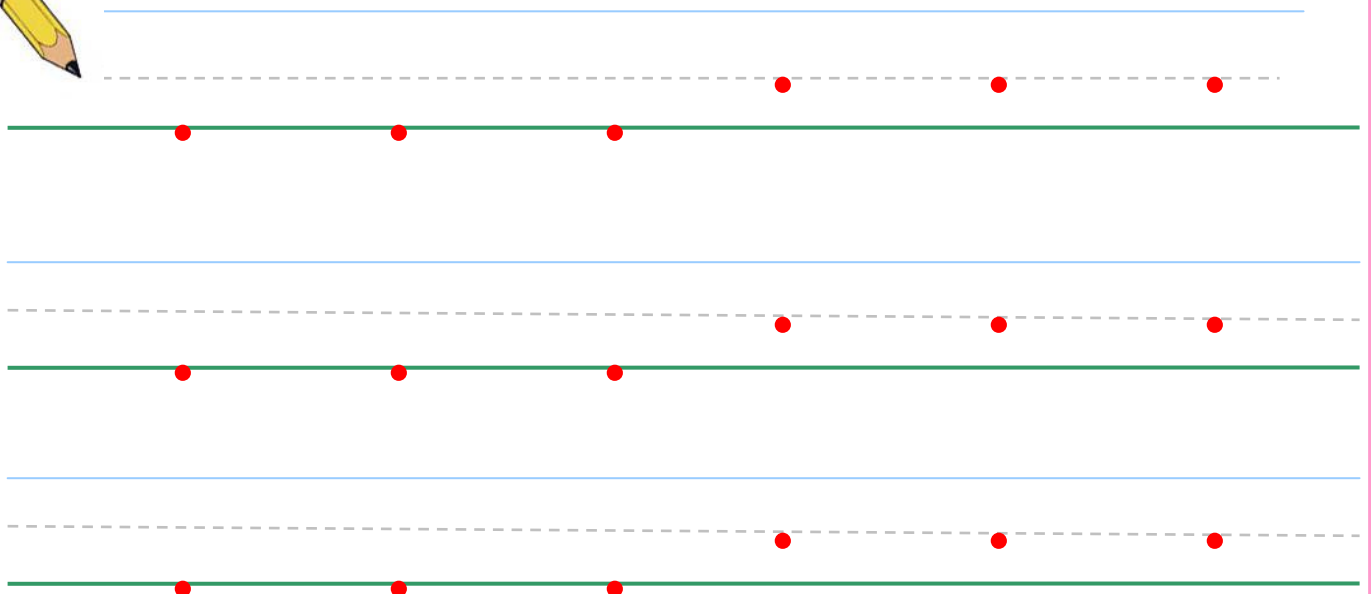
Trace the letters below, can you do ALL of them?
