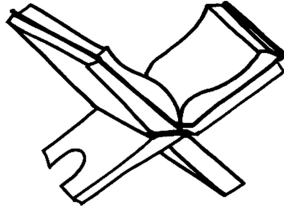
How to Use This Book

English Transliteration

*“Laa-e-laa-ba il-lal-laah, Moo-ham-ma-door
ra-soo-lool-laah”*

Translation

*“There is no god except Allah, and Muhammad (peace be upon him) is the
messenger of Allah.”*

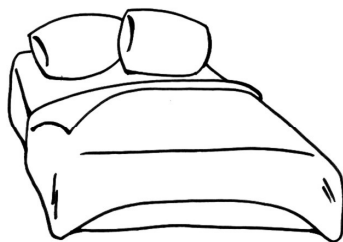
New vocabulary

Witness

To “know and say” that something is true. You can substitute the words “know and say” in the translation to help them understand the meaning of witness.

Messenger

Someone who brings something from someone else. In this case Rasulullah ﷺ brought the Qur’an from Allah ﷻ to all of us so that we could be good and know what Allah ﷻ wants us to do.



Unit 2A: Sleeping

English Transliteration

“Bis-mik al-laa-hoo-ma a-moo-too wa ab-yaa”

Translation

“In your (Allah’s) name I die and I live.”

New vocabulary

Die

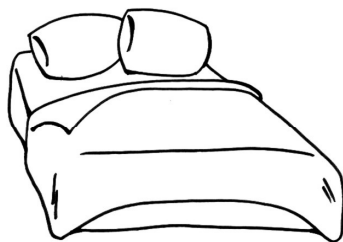
When someone dies that means they don’t eat, drink, or breathe any more. They are washed and put in the grave. Only his “nafs” (soul) keeps living and the soul will either go to ‘Jannah’ (heaven) if the person was good or go to the ‘Jahannam’ (hellfire) if the person was bad.

Jannah (Jan-nah)

A garden that is very special. It has everything beautiful and good in it. And only the good people that listen to Allah ﷻ will be able to go there after they die.

Jahannam (Ja-han-nam)

A fire that is full of everything bad and terrible. Only the very worst people will go there because they did not listen to Allah ﷻ and did bad things.



unit 2B: Waking

الْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ الَّذِي
أَحْيَانَا بَعْدَ مَا أَمَاتَنَا
وَإِلَيْهِ النُّشُورُ

English Transliteration

“Al-ham-doo lil-laa-hil-la-dthee ah-yaa-naa ba’-da maa a-maa-ta-na wa e-lay-bin noo-shoor”

Translation

“Praise be to Allah who brought us back to life after we were dead and to Him we will be gathered.”

New vocabulary

Praise

To say that something is good. In this case Allah ﷻ is good and we are thanking Him for giving us another day to live.

Gathered

On the Day of Judgment we will all be brought back to life just like waking up in the morning and we will come to Allah ﷻ altogether to be judged for our actions.



unit 3: Dressing

English Transliteration

“Al-ham-doo lil-laa bil-la-dthee ka-saa-nee baa-dtha thowba wa-ra-za-qa-nee-be min ghay-ree how-lin min-nee wa- la qoow-wa”

Translation

“All praise is due to Allah who has clothed me with this garment and provided it for me with no power nor might from myself.”

New vocabulary

Power

To be able to do something.

Garment

A piece of clothing (i.e. pants, shirt, scarf, etc.)
