## ***Simplified English Translation***

The following is a simplified translation that can be used with young children. However, it must be remembered that this is not the actual translation of the ayah; rather it is a discussion of the main points in simplified vocabulary. We want children to understand what is being read but at the same time we do not want to undermine the actual Qur’anic ayah or legitimate translations of the text. For a complete translation of the ayah please see Surah 2, Verse 225 of an English Translation of the Qur’an (such as the Yusuf Ali version).

“There is no other god except Allah. He does not die and he takes care of everything, he lives forever. He does not get tired and he does not need to sleep. Everything belongs to Allah even if it is in the sky or on the earth. Nobody can say or do anything that Allah does not want them to do, unless He gives them permission. Allah knows everything that happens to us. No one can know what Allah knows unless Allah lets him know it. Allah has a throne that is bigger and greater than the sky and the earth. Allah does not get tired of taking care of everything because He is greater than everything and He can take care of everything”

## **English Translation**

“To Allah belongs all that is in the heavens and on earth. Whether ye show what is in your minds or conceal it, Allah calls you to account for it. He forgives whom He pleases, and punishes whom He pleases, for Allah hath power over all things.”

“The Messenger believes in what hath been revealed to him from his Lord, as do the men of faith. Each one (of them) believes in Allah, His angels, His books, and His messengers. "We make no distinction (they say) between one and another of His messengers." And they say: "We hear, and we obey: (We seek) Thy forgiveness, our Lord, and to Thee is the end of all journeys."

“On no soul doth Allah place a burden greater than it can bear. It gets every good that it earns, and it suffers every ill that it earns. (Pray:) "Our Lord! Condemn us not if we forget or fall into error; our Lord! Lay not on us a burden Like that which Thou didst lay on those before us; Our Lord!
