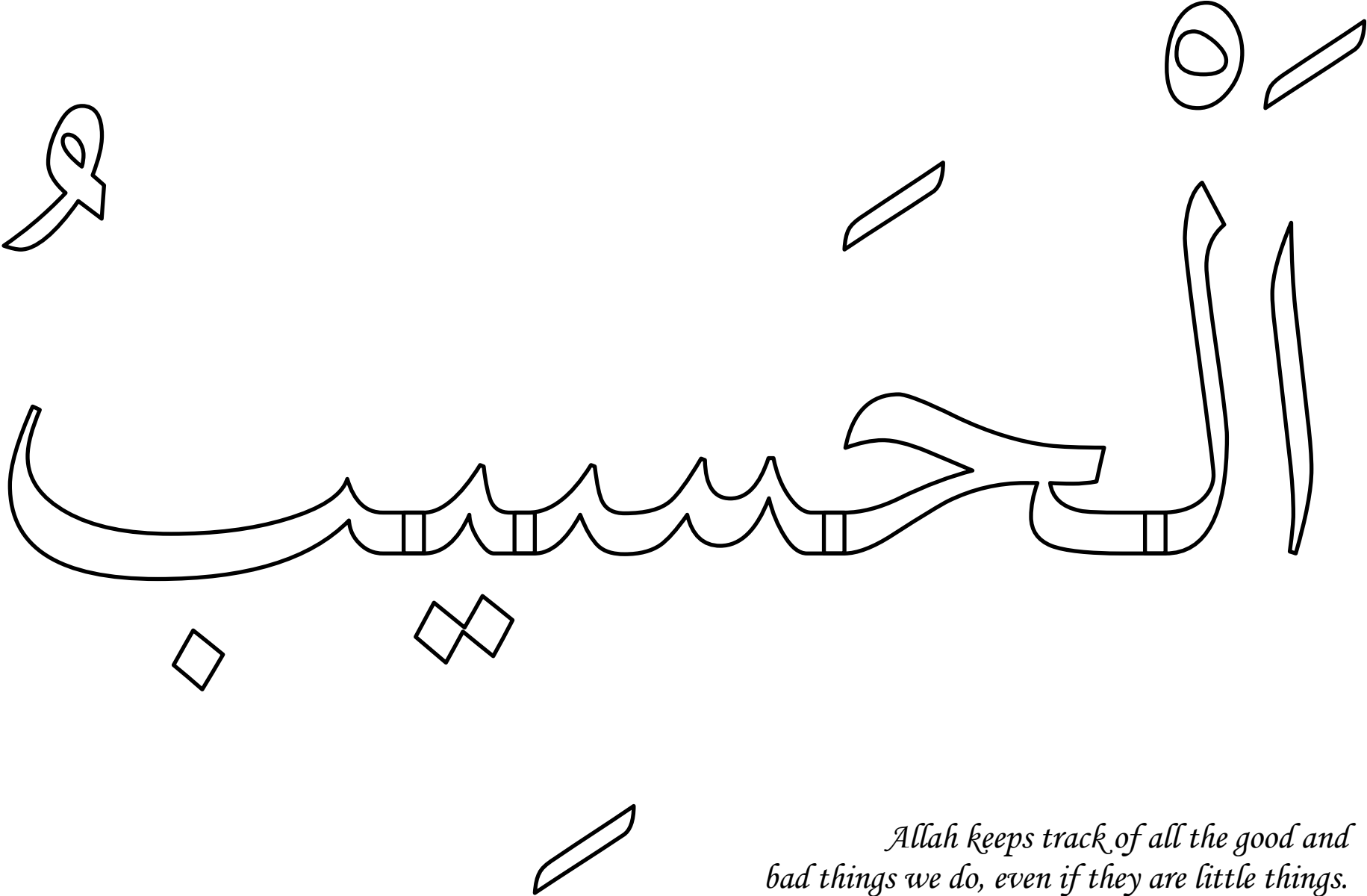
Introduction:

This coloring book is intended to accompany the Asmaa' Ul-Husnaa lessons in Level B of the Ad-Duha Islamic Studies & Arabic Program. Each coloring page consists of the following features:

1. Introduction of an attribute of Allah (sublime and glorified be He) in Arabic. (Note: Names #41-99 are covered in this book, for names #1-40 see Al-Asmaa' ul-Husnaa Coloring Book for Level A).
2. English translation of the basic meaning of the attribute.
3. Arabic letters have been separated with lines to help illustrate how Arabic letters are joined to form words. This has been done to help reinforce the lessons that are being taught in the Arabic Curriculum.
4. Accompanying each attribute is a brief description that illustrates in elementary language the particular attribute of Allah, thus reinforcing the lesson focus of the accompanying Asmaa' Ul-Husnaa lessons.

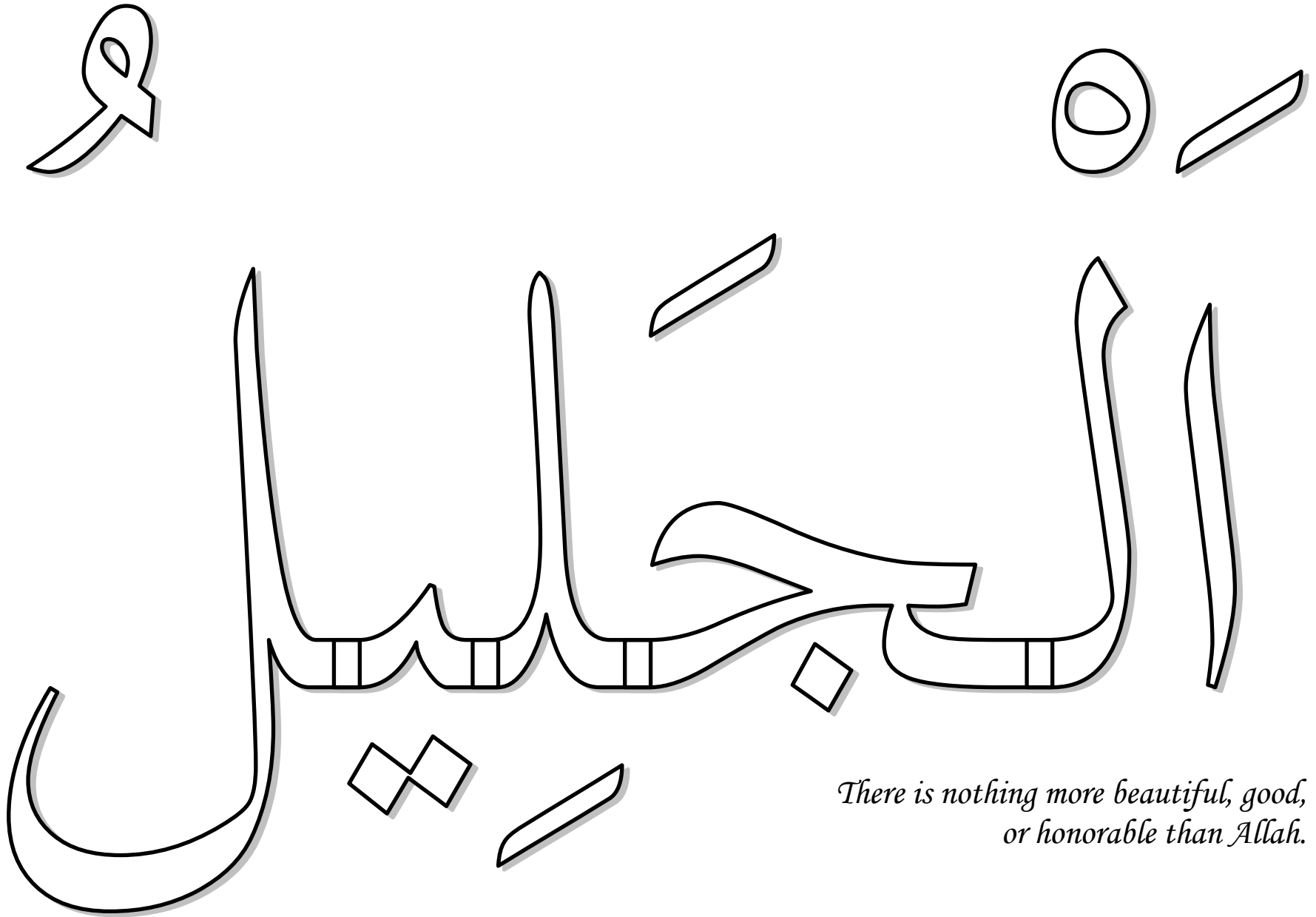
