(Ee-laa-fee-him rih-la-tash-shi-taa-ee was-sayf)

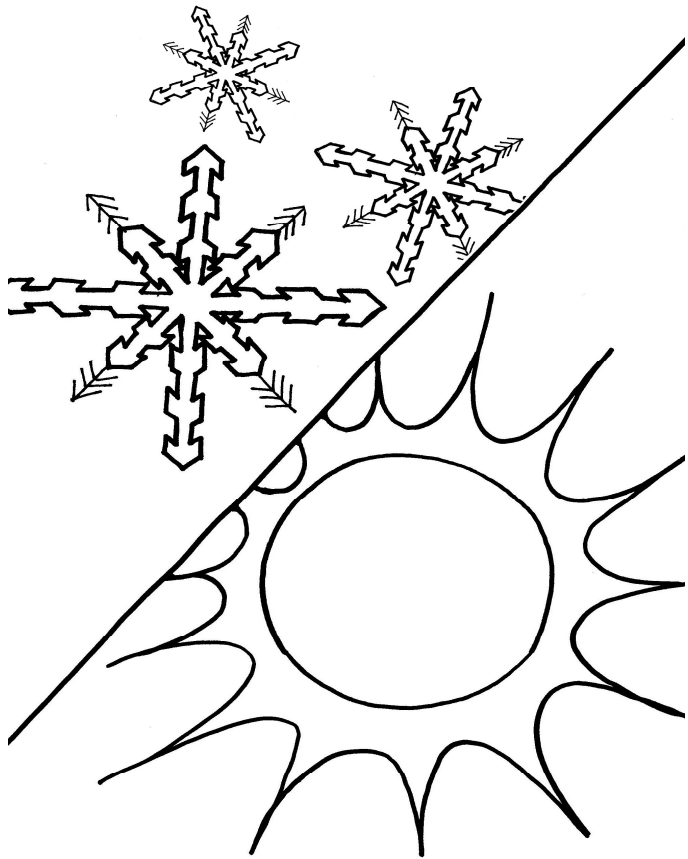

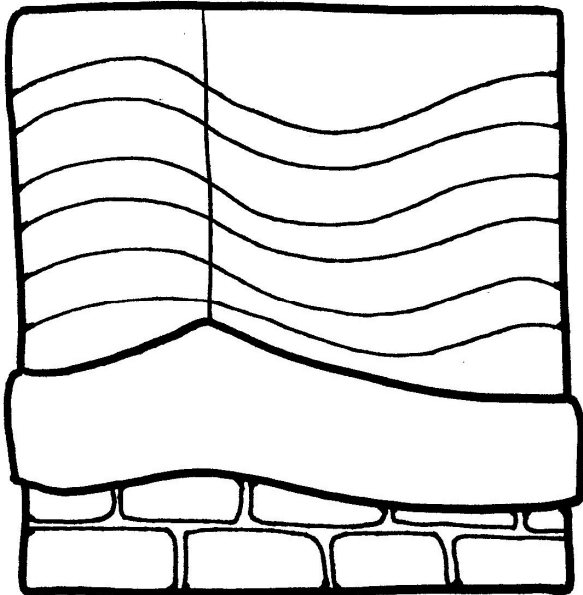

“Who provides them with food against hunger,”

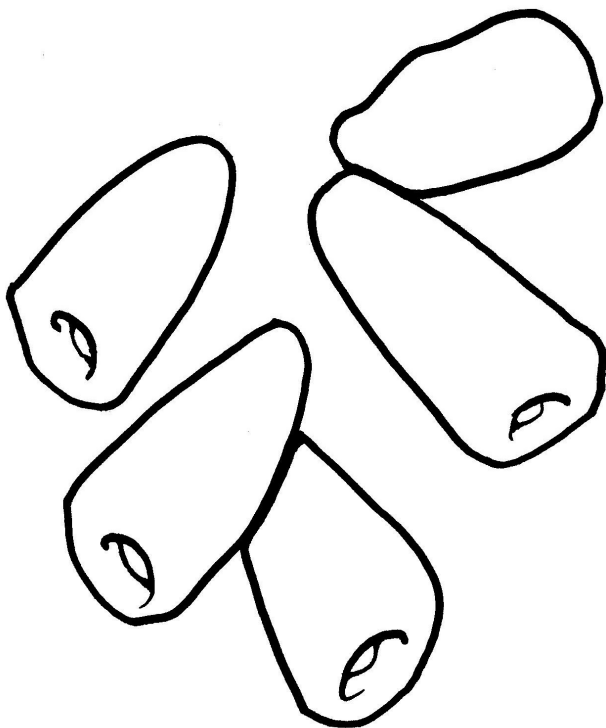
(Al-la-thee at-‘a-ma-hoom min joo’)
