How to Use These Books

The Mini Tafseer Book Series is designed to teach children the Tafseer (exegesis) of all the suwaar (chapters) in the 30th Part of the Qur'aan. Each book in this 38 book series covers a different surah. The books feature:

- Special facts about the surah
- Arabic text of the surah
- English transliteration (to assist non-Arabic speakers)
- English translation
- Simplified Tafseer
- Coloring pages
- Highlighted Arabic vocabulary (linked to Ad-Duha Qur'aan lessons)
- One sentence summary of what the surah is about
- Review section
- Notes on the text (additional facts and information)

Teaching Tips:

If your younger child has trouble going through the whole book in one sitting, or does not retain all of the information taught, then just focus on the Tafseer pages first (i.e. those that explain the verses of the surah) and save the additional information contained in the Quick Facts, What's Special, Asbaab An-Nuzool, and Vocabulary sections* for later when your child has mastered the Tafseer.

For older or advanced students who need more of a challenge, you can take time to go through all sections and discuss the lesson notes for that section (located at the end of the text). This will make lessons more challenging and provide a deeper understanding of the Tafseer, and Allah knows best.

When it was revealed, Allah gave instructions for Rasulullah ﷺ to recite it to one of his companions whose name was...

Ubayy Ibn Ka'b رضي الله عنه

Rasulullah ﷺ told Ubayy what Allah had told him to do, so Ubayy asked...

"He (Allah) mentioned me by name to you?"

Rasulullah ﷺ replied, "Yes."

When Ubayy heard this he cried. ² He could not believe that Allah would mention him by name, it was such an **honor**.

1. Sahaaba

He was one of the companions of the Prophet ﷺ.

2. Ansaar

He was one of the Muslims from Madinah known as the "Helpers".

3. Moojaahid

He participated in the Battle of Badr as well as many other battles with Rasulallah ﷺ .

4. Prophet's Scribe

He was one of the men who would write the verses of the Qur'aan down as Rasulallah ﷺ received them.

5. Best Recitor of the Qur'aan

Rasulallah ﷺ told the Muslims to learn Qur'aan from him.

6. Hufaazdh

He memorized the entire Qur'aan.

7. Wrote a Moos-huf

He wrote a copy of the Qur'aan for his own personal study even before the final copy of the Qur'aan was written at the time of Uthman رضى الله عنه .

Why did Allah want Rasulullah ﷺ
to recite this surah to Ubayy?

Rasulullah ﷺ did not tell us the exact reason, so we do not know for sure.

However, since Bayyinah is all about the **books** that Allah sent to guide human beings, and Ubayy loved the book of Allah very much, it is not surprising that Allah would want him to be the one to write this surah down, and Allah knows best.

Now that we have learned what is so special about Suratul-Bayyinah, let's get ready to learn what Suratul-Bayyinah is all about!
