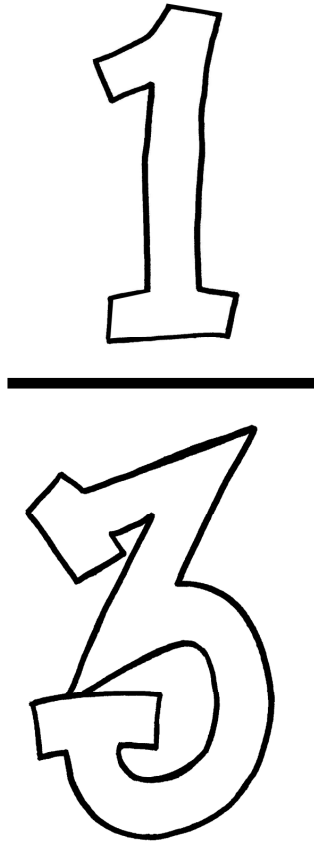

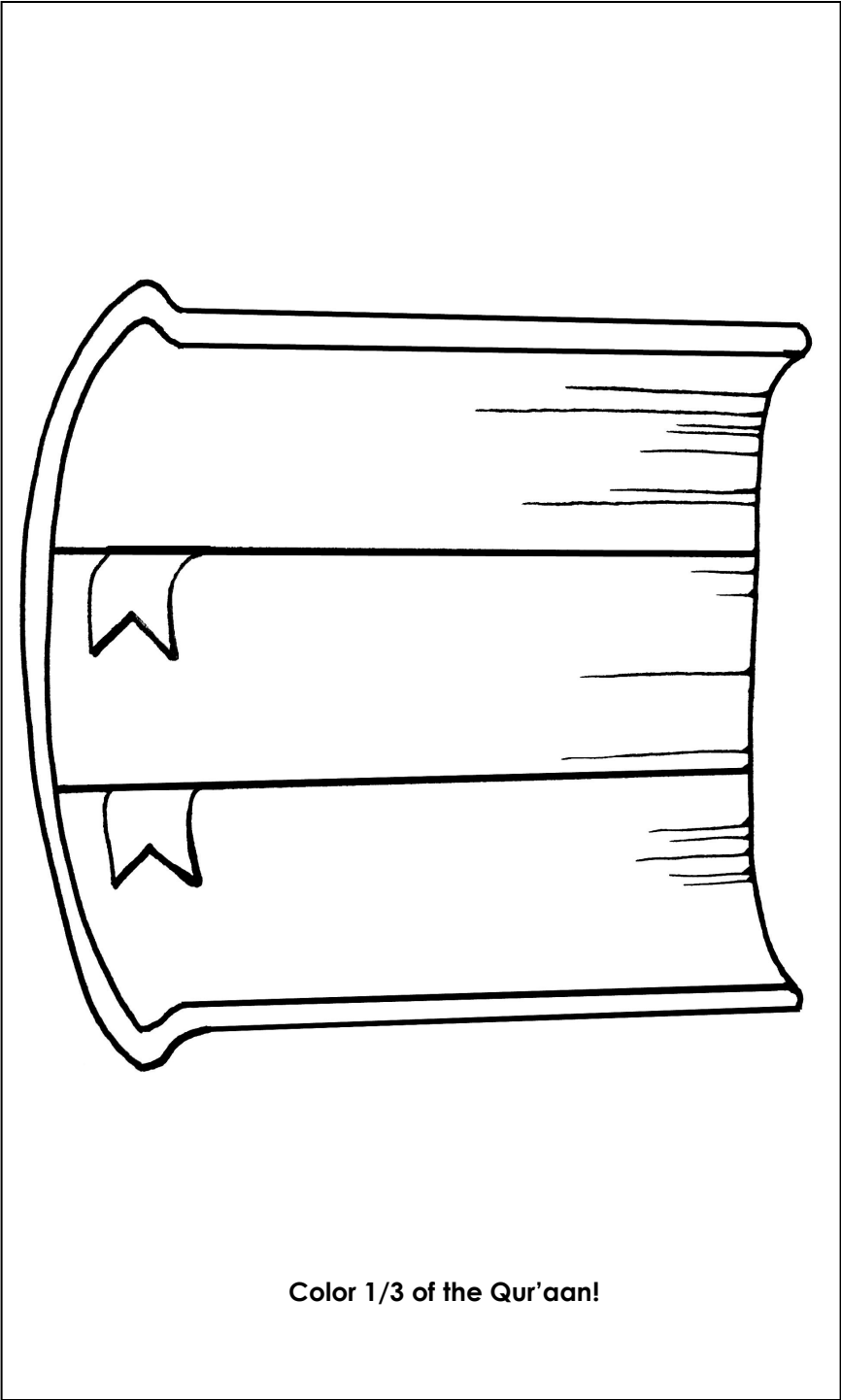

The first thing that is **so special** about Suratul-Ikhlaas is that reading it is equal to reading...



of the Qur'aan!

You can remember that it is equal to one **third** of the Qur'aan¹ because it is the **third** surah from the end of the Qur'aan!

The second thing that is **so special**
about Suratul-Ikhlaas is...

Whoever truly loves Allah,
and loves Suratul-Ikhlaas
(because it is all about Allah), will...

Enter
Jannah!

There was a man from the Ansaar²
at the time of Rasulallahﷺ who
loved Suratul-Ikhlaas so much that he
would recite it in every prayer!

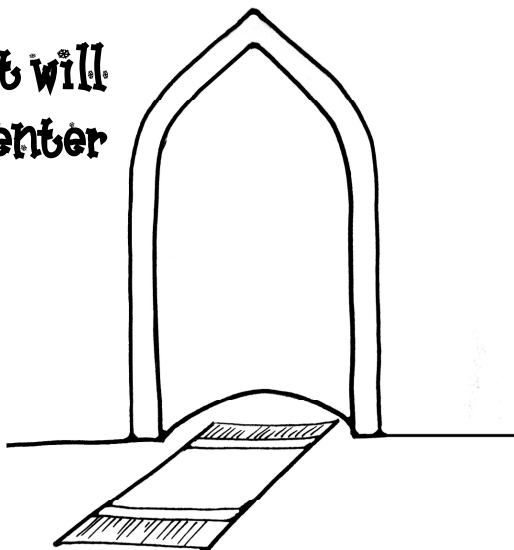
He did this even when he was leading other
people in prayer at the masjid.³

He did it for every salaah, every day,
all year long!

The people were getting tired of the same
surah all the time. They thought he should
stop doing that.

So, they went to Rasulallahﷺ to complain.
Rasulallahﷺ asked the man why he liked to
recite Suratul-Ikhlaas all the time. He said
that he loved it. Then Rasulallahﷺ said...

**"Your love of it will
cause you to enter
Jannah."**⁴

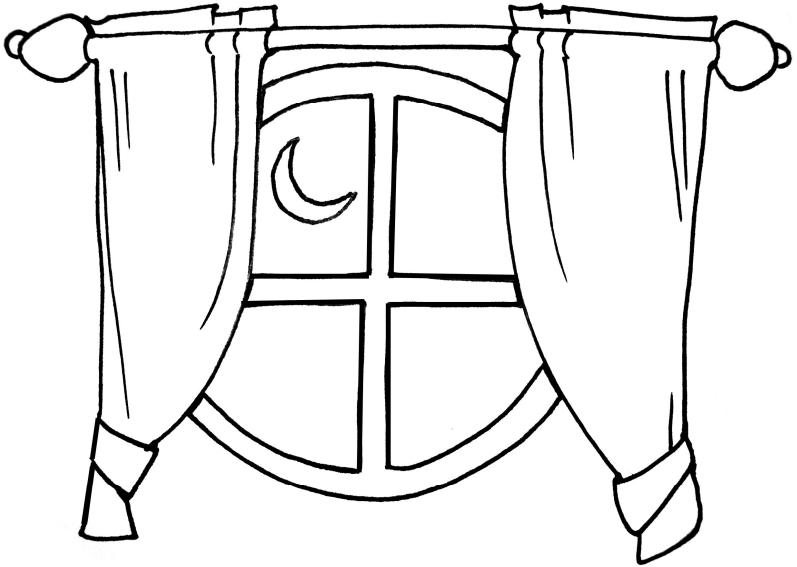


The third thing that is **so special** about Suratul-Ikhlaas is that...

Rasulullah ﷺ loved reciting it **3 times** (along with Suratun-Naas and Suratul-Falaq) before he **went to sleep** each night!

Rasulullah's wife, Aishah رَضِيَ اللهُ عَنْهَا, said that before he went to bed he would blow into his hands, recite Suratul-Ikhlaas, Suratun-Naas and Suratul-Falaq, and then wipe his hands over his whole body (head and face first, then the front of his body, then as far as he could reach). He would do this three times. ⁵

Keep a look out for the following vocabulary words while you read! These words will help you remember the meaning of Surat-ul-Ikhlaas, insha-Allah!

One
(In this case, Allah is "One")

أَحَدٌ

The Eternal
(This is a name of Allah)

الصَّمَدُ

To have children
(In this case, Allah does not have children)

يَلِدُ

Equal or comparable
(In this case, nothing is like Allah)

كُفُوًا
