Suratul-Qaari'ah was one of the **very first suwaar to be revealed** to Rasulullah ﷺ.¹

Suratul-Qaari'ah was revealed in **Makkah**, before the Hijrah to Madinah.²

Suratul-Qaari'ah is named after the word "**Al-Qaari'ah**" (which means "the noise or calamity") used in the first ayah.
